When you arrive at the St. Louis Airport, take the Metro (rapid transit) to Washington University. Tickets will be provided or can be purchase at any station. Be sure to validate your ticket (stamp it in the time machine) before you get on the train. Board the Red Line heading to the city; exit at the Forest Park – DeBaliviere station, and board the next Blue Line train going west to Shrewsbury. Get off the train at the second stop, University City – Big Bend. On exiting the Metro station walk south on Big Bend one short block; turn left (east) on Snow Way to the end of the second dorm on the left, Villages (see Danforth Campus map 2). The Knight Center is three buildings down the road on the right.

All other venues on the Danforth Campus are within a short walking distance – see Danforth Campus map 2 for the locations of the DUC (Danforth University Center – food service) and the Natural Sciences Learning Center in the Biology Dept (computer lab).

The Life Sciences building is located at Forsyth Blvd and Tolman Way. Enter the building through the door marked “Biology,” immediately back of the greenhouses (easily recognized – just look for lots of glass, with plants inside). Turn right, and in a few feet turn left through the double doors into the lounge area. The Computer Lab is through the door on your left.
